Meeting Objective

1) Diversion Update

- Diversion rates shown based on data available to OTS in late May 2011 (OTS notes that some data not yet finalized despite revised submission timelines) for Q1 2012
- Data presented is in DRAFT at this time
- Collection figures for PLT and MT down slightly over last year, OTR volume is up

Tire Category	Diversion Rate
PLT	86%
MT	91%
OTR	118%



2) Tire Collection Update

- Tires being collected from locations by Haulers as applicable
- No issues to report



3) Tire Transportation & Delivery

Ad Hocs & Redirects: requests for OTRs redirects/ad hocs remain high, very few On Road requests (only for cut MTs; OTS currently looking into ways to deter cutting of tires from rims)

Ad Hoc and Redirects:

Ad Hocs authorized in March = 14

Ad Hocs authorized in April = 8

Ad Hocs authorized in May = 6

Redirects authorized in March =8

Redirects authorized in April = 17

Redirects authorized in May = 12

3) Tire Transportation & Delivery

b) STC Review/Updates:

Number of STCs approved in April: 9

Number of STCs approved in May: 1

Note: STC requests have slowed again



4) Tire Processing & Manufacturing Update

- Capacity for all tires types increased over last year on average
- Variations still seen with OTR capacity
- Manufacturers: actively participating in promotional activities with OTS
- Additional out of province processor available to handle OTR tires



5) Claims Update

- Collector Claims:
- Collector claims filing in accordance with typical trends
- Hauler Claims:
- Issues with "negative inventory" continue; typically a result of data entry errors, tire misclassifications (misclassifications can lead to delays in claim processing as it is sometimes difficult to identify the error) or missing paperwork
- Haulers filing in accordance with typical trends



5) Claims Update

Processor Claims:

Processors claims continue to be filed as normal

RPM Claims:

Continue to file as usual



6) Stockpile Update

- OTS is working with stockpile sites to come up with removal options
- Participants with questions regarding stockpiles can direct them to info@ontariots.ca
- New stockpile approach (RPF option) is currently being developed internally for issuance by OTS in the coming weeks/months
- Contract awards will consider end use of material (i.e. TDP type and supply to an RPM) as well as cost
- Currently the team is assessing the stockpile locations with the assistance of MoE enforcement officers to determine the status/condition of the stockpile



7) Program Communications

Refresher Training Sessions:

- Currently no refresher training sessions are planned
- Individual training sessions continue as applicable (typically with new participants)

Other Communication Updates:

- HST notices and ruling sent to all stakeholders this month
- OTS will provide updates as requested to stakeholders and continue efforts to provide company specific assessments to Haulers and Collectors
- Tire Life Check Tour (June 16 Labour Day): TLC will be visiting 40+
 festivals across the province. The tour team will be delivering TDP prize
 packs to local radio stations in order to secure interviews and tweeting
 live updates from the field.
